Air Freight News - April 2025

Global Air Cargo Market Faces Tariff-Induced Volatility

The global air cargo market is experiencing increased volatility due to new tariffs and capacity constraints. While the overall Baltic Air Freight Index (BAIOO) dipped slightly by 1.07% from February to March, underlying factors such as tariff-driven urgency and regional disparities are reshaping the market dynamics.

Asia-Pacific Airfreight Rates Surge Amid Tariff Concerns

In the Asia-Pacific region, airfreight rates have seen a significant increase, with pricing jumping 4% week-over-week. The average spot rate out of the region rose by 5%, reaching \$3.94, as shippers expedite cargo ahead of impending U.S. tariffs.

Operational Challenges in Europe and North America

Air cargo operations from Europe to North America are facing disruptions due to new security measures and labor shortages. Major European hubs like Schiphol and Liege are expanding freighter capacity to manage peaks, while U.S. carriers contend with staffing challenges at key airports, leading to delays and rate volatility.

Blank Sailings Increase Amid Trade Uncertainty

Container-shipping companies are increasingly canceling or delaying voyages from Asia to the U.S. and Europe, a trend known as "blank sailings." This move is in response to declining demand and the ongoing trade tensions, with 68 sailings globally expected to be canceled during April.

European Ports Face Congestion Due to Rerouted Shipments

The escalating trade war between the U.S. and China has led to severe congestion at major European ports. Hundreds of ships are stranded due to canceled orders and rerouted shipments, as new tariffs disrupt global shipping operations.

Maersk Launches New Transpacific Service

Maersk has introduced a new direct service from Turkey to the U.S. East Coast, aiming to enhance reliability and efficiency in its network. This move is part of Maersk's efforts to adapt to the changing trade landscape and provide consistent service amid global disruptions.
